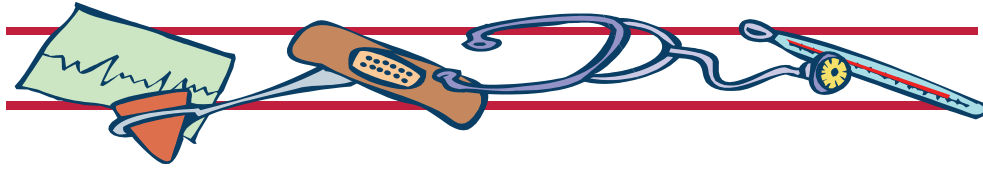


Health Policy



Certain state health forms are required for enrollment in any childcare setting in California. If your child shows an signs of illness (rash, irritability, listlessness, vomiting, temperature, etc.), he/she **MUST** be kept at home.

By enforcing this policy we are able to maintain a healthy environment for all children in our schools.

If a child shows symptoms of an infectious illness during their stay at school, the parent/sponsor will be contacted to pick him/her up within one hour from the time of telephone contact.

Children must be free of symptoms for 24 hours before they may return to school.

The Symptoms are as follows:

1. Diarrhea
2. Fever of 100 degrees or above
3. Cough with mucous secretion
4. Any unknown rash or skin infection
5. Vomiting
6. Pinkeye
7. Head lice, hair must be lice and nit free prior to re-admittance to school.
8. Inconsolable, irritable discomfort
9. Heavy nasal discharge indicating an infection
10. Contagious illness, such as Chicken Pox

We encourage our students from preschool through elementary to make healthy decisions regarding diet, exercise and preventative attention to physical needs.

Because fresh air is essential to a child's well being, we plan to play out-of-doors every day weather permitting.

Please dress children accordingly. A child not able to play outside should remain home until well.
